

Lip Blush Pre-Care

30 DAYS BEFORE PROCEDURE:

Avoid fillers and botox in the lip area

2WEEKS BEFORE PROCEDURE:

- Avoid Glycolic acid, chemical peels, and laser treatments on the face
- · Avoid sun and tanning

1WEEK BEFORE PROCEDURE:

- Avoid all facials, bleaching treatments, or waxings around the lip area
- Keep your lips well hydrated with a good lip balm and drinking lots of water

24 HOURS BEFORE YOUR PROCEDURE:

- NO alcohol or caffeine
- Do not take Aspirin, Niacin, Vitamin E or Advil/Ibuprofen as they act as blood thinner
- Do not wear any lipstick for your appointment
- Your lips should be cleaned with a regular facial cleanser

Please note: If you have been prone to any type of cold sores (herpes simplex virus), this procedure could cause an outbreak. It is best to consult with your doctor and upon your doctor's recommendation, take doctor-prescribed or over-the-counter medication such as Acyclovir, Zovirax, or Valtrex days prior to and after the lip procedure to help prevent or lessen the severity of an outbreak.

***Failure to follow these instructions can lead to bleeding during the procedure, severe inflammation of the treated area, low pigment retention and poor healed results.
